Educational camps focusing on **Quantum technologies** and the **German language** at the Goethe-Instituts in **Riga, Berlin, Lyon and Brussels** through 2026-27. For teenagers aged 16-18 and teachers from the EU and the UK. **Apply now!**

## What is this project about?

- Funded by the German Federal Ministry of Education and Research, this project is organised by the *Goethe-Institut* and the German educational thinktank *Junge Tüftler\*innen*
- It aims to introduce students to quantum technologies through hands-on workshops during a week-long camp
- Beginners' German classes intended to spark interest in study or professional opportunities in Germany
- Scholarship: camp includes input sessions, excursions, the creation of individual professional development plans and a rewarding leisure programme

## What do the camps entail?

- Hands-on workshops revolving around quantum technologies
- Interactive German lessons (incl. 1 week online lessons prior to camp)
- A public event exhibiting the students' work at the end of the week
- Cultural programme activities, leisure time

After successful camps through 2024-25 at the Goethe-Instituts in Dublin, Rome, Madrid, London and Sofia, we are thrilled to have received further funding to continue the camps in these four cities through 2026-27.

## Who can apply?

- Groups of **two students and one teacher** from the EU and the UK can apply. A pre-existing interest in STEM subjects is an advantage, but teachers and students from all subjects are welcome to apply!
- Students must be between 16-18 years of age.

## Language and proficiency

- The camps are held through English
- English proficiency at B2 level is required for both students and teachers
- Students require at least A1 proficiency in German (teachers do not require German proficiency)

## What do the camps cost?

- Scholarship for all participating students and teachers (incl. flights, accommodation, catering, leisure programme, workshop content). Some costs such as transport to the airport or some meals are not included.
